



"Light" in the New Testament

Matthew

MT 4:16 The people that sat in darkness Saw a great light, And to them that sat in the region and shadow of death, To them did light spring up.

MT 5:14 Ye are the light of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hid.

MT 5:15 Neither do `men' light a lamp, and put it under the bushel, but on the stand; and it shineth unto all that are in the house.

MT 5:16 Even so let your light shine before men; that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father who is in heaven.

MT 6:22 The lamp of the body is the eye: if therefore thine eye be single, thy whole body shall be full of light.

MT 6:23 But if thine eye be evil, thy whole body shall be full of darkness. If therefore the light that is in thee be darkness, how great is the darkness!

MT 10:27 What I tell you in the darkness, speak ye in the light; and what ye hear in the ear, proclaim upon the house-tops.

MT 17:2 and he was transfigured before them; and his face did shine as the sun, and his garments became white as the light.

MT 24:29 But immediately after the tribulation of those days the sun shall be darkened, and the moon shall not give her light, and the stars shall fall from heaven, and the powers of the heavens shall be shaken:

Mark

MK 4:22 For there is nothing hid, save that it should be manifested; neither was `anything' made secret, but that it should come to light.

MK 13:24 But in those days, after that tribulation, the sun shall be darkened, and the moon shall not give her light,

MK 14:54 And Peter had followed him afar off, even within, into the court of the high priest; and he was sitting with the officers, and warming himself in the light `of the fire'.

Luke

LK 2:32 A light for revelation to the Gentiles, And the glory of thy people I srael.

LK 8:16 And no man, when he hath lighted a lamp, covereth it with a vessel, or putteth it under a bed; but putteth it on a stand, that they that enter in may see the light.

LK 8:17 For nothing is hid, that shall not be made manifest; nor `anything' secret, that shall not be known and come to light.



LK 11:33 No man, when he hath lighted a lamp, putteth it in a cellar, neither under the bushel, but on the stand, that they which enter in may see the light.

LK 11:34 The lamp of thy body is thine eye: when thine eye is single, thy whole body also is full of light; but when it is evil, thy body also is full of darkness.

LK 11:35 Look therefore whether the light that is in thee be not darkness.

LK 11:36 If therefore thy whole body be full of light, having no part dark, it shall be wholly full of light, as when the lamp with its bright shining doth give thee light.

LK 12:3 Wherefore whatsoever ye have said in the darkness shall be heard in the light; and what ye have spoken in the ear in the inner chambers shall be proclaimed upon the housetops.

LK 15:8 Or what woman having ten pieces of silver, if she lose one piece, doth not light a lamp, and sweep the house, and seek diligently until she find it?

LK 16:8 And his lord commended the unrighteous steward because he had done wisely: for the sons of this world are for their own generation wiser than the sons of the light.

LK 17:24 for as the lightning, when it lighteneth out of the one part under the heaven, shineth unto the other part under heaven; so shall the Son of man be in his day.

LK 22:56 And a certain maid seeing him as he sat in the light `of the fire', and looking stedfastly upon him, said, This man also was with him.

LK 23:45 the sun's light failing: and the veil of the temple was rent in the midst.

John

JN 1:4 In him was life; and the life was the light of men.

JN 1:5 And the light shineth in the darkness; and the darkness apprehended it not.

JN 1:7 The same came for witness, that he might bear witness of the light, that all might believe through him.

JN 1:8 He was not the light, but `came' that he might bear witness of the light.

JN 1:9 There was the true light, `even the light' which lighteth every man, coming into the world.

JN 3:19 And this is the judgment, that the light is come into the world, and men loved the darkness rather than the light; for their works were evil.

JN 3:20 For every one that doeth evil hateth the light, and cometh not to the light, lest his works should be reprov'd.

JN 3:21 But he that doeth the truth cometh to the light, that his works may be made manifest, that they have been wrought in God.

JN 5:35 He was the lamp that burneth and shineth; and ye were willing to rejoice for a season in his light.

JN 8:12 Again therefore Jesus spake unto them, saying, I am the light of the world: he that followeth me shall not walk in the darkness, but shall have the light of life.



JN 9:5 When I am in the world, I am the light of the world.

JN 11:9 Jesus answered, Are there not twelve hours in the day? If a man walk in the day, he stumbleth not, because he seeth the light of this world.

JN 11:10 But if a man walk in the night, he stumbleth, because the light is not in him.

JN 12:35 Jesus therefore said unto them, Yet a little while is the light among you. Walk while ye have the light, that darkness overtake you not: and he that walketh in the darkness knoweth not whither he goeth.

JN 12:36 While ye have the light, believe on the light, that ye may become sons of light. These things spake Jesus, and he departed and hid himself from them.

JN 12:46 I am come a light into the world, that whosoever believeth on me may not abide in the darkness.

Acts

ACTS 9:3 And as he journeyed, it came to pass that he drew nigh unto Damascus: and suddenly there shone round about him a light out of heaven:

ACTS 12:7 And behold, an angel of the Lord stood by him, and a light shined in the cell: and he smote Peter on the side, and awoke him, saying, Rise up quickly. And his chains fell off from his hands.

ACTS 13:47 For so hath the Lord commanded us, `saying', I have set thee for a light of the Gentiles, That thou shouldest be for salvation unto the uttermost part of the earth.

ACTS 20:8 And there were many lights in the upper chamber where we were gathered together.

ACTS 22:6 And it came to pass, that, as I made my journey, and drew nigh unto Damascus, about noon, suddenly there shone from heaven a great light round about me.

ACTS 22:9 And they that were with me beheld indeed the light, but they heard not the voice of him that spake to me.

ACTS 22:11 And when I could not see for the glory of that light, being led by the hand of them that were with me I came into Damascus.

ACTS 26:13 at midday, O king, I saw on the way a light from heaven, above the brightness of the sun, shining round about me and them that journeyed with me.

ACTS 26:18 to open their eyes, that they may turn from darkness to light and from the power of Satan unto God, that they may receive remission of sins and an inheritance among them that are sanctified by faith in me.

ACTS 26:23 how that the Christ must suffer, `and' how that he first by the resurrection of the dead should proclaim light both to the people and to the Gentiles.

ACTS 27:38 And when they had eaten enough, they lightened the ship, throwing out the wheat into the sea.



ACTS 27:41 But lighting upon a place where two seas met, they ran the vessel aground; and the foreship struck and remained unmoveable, but the stern began to break up by the violence `of the waves'.

Paul

ROM 2:19 and art confident that thou thyself art a guide of the blind, a light of them that are in darkness,

ROM 13:12 The night is far spent, and the day is at hand: let us therefore cast off the works of darkness, and let us put on the armor of light.

1COR 4:5 Wherefore judge nothing before the time, until the Lord come, who will both bring to light the hidden things of darkness, and make manifest the counsels of the hearts; and then shall each man have his praise from God.

2COR 4:4 in whom the god of this world hath blinded the minds of the unbelieving, that the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God, should not dawn `upon them'.

2COR 4:6 Seeing it is God, that said, Light shall shine out of darkness, who shined in our hearts, to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ.

2COR 6:14 Be not unequally yoked with unbelievers: for what fellowship have righteousness and iniquity? or what communion hath light with darkness?

2COR 11:14 And no marvel; for even Satan fashioneth himself into an angel of light.

EPH 1:18 having the eyes of your heart enlightened, that ye may know what is the hope of his calling, what the riches of the glory of his inheritance in the saints,

EPH 5:8 For ye were once darkness, but are now light in the Lord: walk as children of light

EPH 5:9 (for the fruit of the light is in all goodness and righteousness and truth),

EPH 5:13 But all things when they are reprov'd are made manifest by the light: for everything that is made manifest is light.

PHIL 2:15 that ye may become blameless and harmless, children of God without blemish in the midst of a crooked and perverse generation, among whom ye are seen as lights in the world,

COL 1:12 giving thanks unto the Father, who made us meet to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in light;

1THESS 5:5 for ye are all sons of light, and sons of the day: we are not of the night, nor of darkness;

1TIM 6:16 who only hath immortality, dwelling in light unapproachable; whom no man hath seen, nor can see: to whom `be' honor and power eternal. Amen.

2TIM 1:10 but hath now been manifested by the appearing of our Saviour Christ Jesus, who abolished death, and brought life and immortality to light through the gospel,



James

JAS 1:17 Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of lights, with whom can be no variation, neither shadow that is cast by turning.

Peter

1PET 2:9 But ye are a elect race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for `God's' own possession, that ye may show forth the excellencies of him who called you out of darkness into his marvellous light:

John

1JN 1:5 And this is the message which we have heard from him and announce unto you, that God is light, and in him is no darkness at all.

1JN 1:7 but if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus his Son cleanseth us from all sin.

1JN 2:8 Again, a new commandment write I unto you, which thing is true in him and in you; because the darkness is passing away, and the true light already shineth.

1JN 2:9 He that saith he is in the light and hateth his brother, is in the darkness even until now.

1JN 2:10 He that loveth his brother abideth in the light, and there is no occasion of stumbling in him.

Revelation

REV 18:23 and the light of a lamp shall shine no more at all in thee; and the voice of the bridegroom and of the bride shall be heard no more at all in thee: for thy merchants were the princes of the earth; for with thy sorcery were all the nations deceived.

REV 21:11 having the glory of God: her light was like unto a stone most precious, as it were a jasper stone, clear as crystal:

REV 21:23 And the city hath no need of the sun, neither of the moon, to shine upon it: for the glory of God did lighten it, and the lamp thereof `is' the Lamb.

REV 21:24 And the nations shall walk amidst the light thereof: and the kings of the earth bring their glory into it.

REV 22:5 And there shall be night no more; and they need no light of lamp, neither light of sun; for the Lord God shall give them light: and they shall reign for ever and ever.
